
Please note these dates in your calendar, and plan to partake of this event. Those not registered before the day will still be welcome and may pay at the entrance on the first day.

If you have a prayer request and would like members of our community to support you in prayer, contact the four key persons – if possible by SMS- and they will inform the others from the prayer chain.

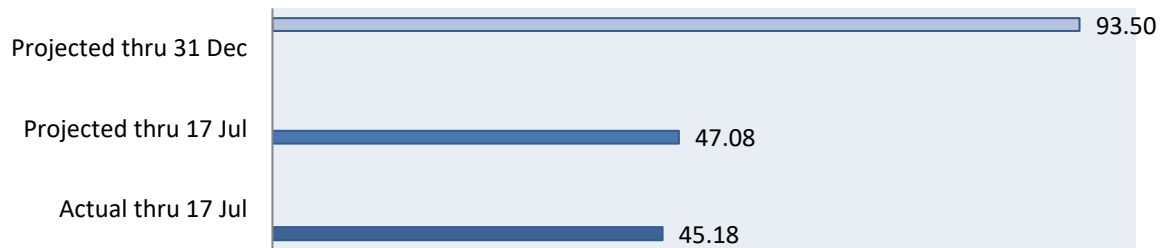

Arusha Community Church 2023 Income through 17 July (in TSh millions)



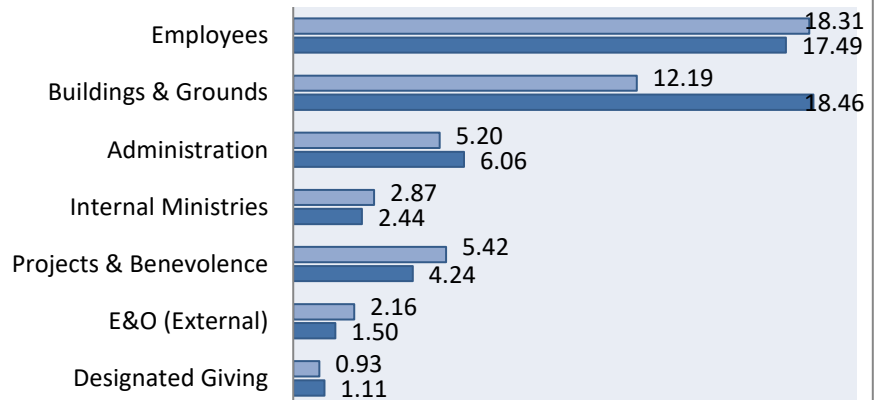
2023 income thru 17 July was TSh 8.51 million higher than the same period last year, but TSh 1.90 million below this year's 17 July target; please consider assisting as able.
